

## **Genesis Ultra TLD-BP**

**Beginning January 1, 2022** Mirion Technologies no longer manufactures or maintains the Genesis Ultra TLD badge. All current users of the Genesis Ultra TLD, will be transitioned to the new TLD-BP badge, pictured below.



You should have received or will soon receive your first set of 2022 badges. To avoid unreturned badge charges, make sure to send all 4th quarter 2021 badges in for processing once 1st quarter 2022 badges are received.


All aspects of your dosimetry service will remain unaffected. Once you receive the new TLD-BP badges, the changes will be reflected on your account, wearer dose records, and invoices.

Just like the Genesis Ultra TLD dosimeter, the Genesis Ultra TLD-BP badge measures beta, X-ray, and neutron radiation, and the technical specifications remain unchanged.

The TLD-BP allows you to keep and reuse the holder and clip, and return only the Blister Pack for processing. **Instructions for shipping are pictured below** or you can <u>click here</u> for additional information.

When returning your badges, please remember that <u>Mirion's Dosimetry Services Division</u> in Irvine, CA has relocated manufacturing and dose operations to Mirion's Oak Ridge, TN manufacturing facility.
